

2022 Warwick Summer School on Practice and Process Studies: Studying Emotion or Affect?

Hybrid 2022 Warwick Summer School on Practice and Process Studies. Online sessions (BST) and in-person attendance (accommodation and travel not included), 12 – 14 July.

The Warwick Summer School convenes scholars interested in practice and process studies in an open and multi-disciplinary learning community characterized by dialogue, discussion, and joint exploration. The Summer School is designed for those with an advanced understanding of practice and process theories. The three days will consider the state-of-the-art of practice, process and routines studies (2 days) and how we can advance practice and process studies on emotion and affect (1 day). The hybrid event will take place online and in-person at Warwick University, UK, for those happy to make their own travel and accommodation arrangements.

2022 Theme: Studying Emotion or Affect?

Each summer school we consider an advanced theme in practice and process studies. This year we will explore the study of emotion and affect. Given the multidisciplinary nature of the summer school we will debate how theories of, and empirical research on, emotion and affect intersect and differ. We are pleased to announce that **Charlene Zietsma**, Professor, Smeal College of Business, Pennsylvania State University, will speak to us about her work on emotional energy and emotions in organizations. **Paul Stenner**, Professor of Social Psychology at The Open University will talk about his work on theorising emotion and affect, and the emotional organization. In addition, Professor **Marianna Fotaki**, Warwick Business School, will share insights from her work on the importance of thinking critically about emotion and affect in organization studies.

Attending the Summer School: The Summer School this year is in hybrid format meaning you have the option to join online or attend in-person. If you wish to attend in-person you will need to make your own accommodation and travel arrangements. During the registration process you'll be able to indicate which way you intend to participate: online or in-person.

Warwick Practice Fellowship: We offer a free place at the Summer School for scholars who are affiliated with an institution outside of Europe, North America, Australasia or East Asia, or who are resident there. We are looking to support scholars who document practices in non-traditional settings.

Applications: Please include in your application a personal statement about your research and the reasons for attending the summer school. Please indicate if you are planning on attending the 'research clinics' and/ or if you would like to be considered for the Warwick Practice Fellowship.
